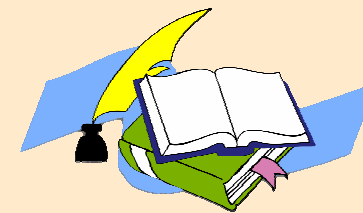

BACKGROUND HISTORY OF PIMS

The PIMS is a national private Upper Secondary institution first established in 1996 by a team led by Mr. Norman Sike (formerly Science/ Physics lecturer at UPNG). As introduced above, the prime factor that led to the establishment of the institute was to provide an alternative continuing education pathway to disadvantaged school leavers (Grade 8,10 or 12) who are pushed out of the mainstream education system. By enrolling at PIMS many students are provided with a second and alternative chance to complete Grade 11& 12 equivalent studies and be in a position where they, like others, are eligible to apply to universities, colleges or places of employment.

In 1997, PIMS achieved full ‘Permitted School’ status with the National Department of Education - Certificate No. PS 444/83. This ‘Permitted Status’ allowed us to run recognized formal secondary courses as a private institution. In the same year, PIMS became one of the first private institutions to become a franchise sub-centre of the then Institute of Distance & Continuing Education (IDCE) – University of Papua New Guinea to run matriculation courses. Following that, in 2003, PIMS again became the first outside private institution to be affiliated to the Department of Open and Distance Learning (DODL) – University of Technology Lae also to run their matriculation courses. Added to all these, just recently in 2010, PIMS was granted approved Registered Study Centre status (RSC Rego. No. 6315) by the FODE (Flexible Open and Distance Education) to run informal secondary courses.

INTRODUCTION

Port Moresby Institute of Matriculation Studies (PIMS) offer its Secondary Formal Program to Grade 8 & 10 Leavers seeking alternative but genuine avenues to continue and complete their Formal Education from Grade 9-12. PIMS welcomes you all such students and rely on our years of experience and commitment in this business to serve our students well and fully. This program is currently only available at the PIMS NCD Centre.

Applicants for Grade 9 places at PIMS., of course, must meet the standard requirement of attaching an acceptable or appropriate Grade 8 certificate to their application.

All new students who have completed Grade 10 and would like to apply to PIMS to do formal Grade 11 will need to meet certain minimum academic pass requirements to be eligible for direct admission into Grade 11.

STUDENT ADMISSION & REGISTRATION

To register for the Secondary (formal) Program, the following requirements and form must be completed step by step:

- *Enrolment Application Form*
- *Produce a copy of the acceptance letter*
- *Cash Paying students must pay Full Term Fee at the start of each term.*
- *Purchase at least 2 full sets of uniforms an proper footwear.*
- *Collect student ID card.*
- *Any other requirements by the school.*

SECONDARY FEE PAYMENT POLICY

The 2022 school fees can be paid off in full (one installment) in the beginning of the year or in 4 quarterly (or term) installments.

All school fees should be deposited to the PIMS Bank A/C at your nearest BSP Bank.
